



1. Reindeer herding safari

After arriving by car to the Reindeer Park at the Arctic Circle our guide will tell us about reindeer husbandry and show how to harness the reindeer. During an enjoyable ride through the snowy forest, we stop at a campfire for a cup of traditional Finnish coffee with cookies. You will have an opportunity to drive the sledge on your own and receive a "Reindeer Driver's Licence". On return to the Park, we unharness and feed the reindeer. Transfer back to town by car.

2. Reindeer safari to the husky farm

We will drive by car to the Reindeer Park at the Arctic Circle. Covered in warm reindeer pelts and blankets, we travel by a reindeer sledge through the snow-covered forest to a husky farm for a short husky sledge ride. We will also hear about the life of these amazing dogs while enjoying hot juice by a campfire. Return by reindeer sledge to the Reindeer Park. Transfer back to town by car.

3. Reindeer safari to Santa's Village

Your guide will take you by car to the Reindeer Park. We learn about reindeer husbandry and meet the reindeer that will pull us by sledges through the winter forest to the Santa Claus Village at the Arctic Circle. You can meet Santa Claus in his chamber and send postcards with a special Arctic Circle stamp from his Main Post Office. You will also have time to visit the handicraft and souvenir shops of Santa's Village. You will receive a "Reindeer Driver's Licence" and a Certificate of Crossing the Arctic Circle as a souvenir. Transfer from Santa's Village back to town by car.

Departure time: 11:00 (duration 4 hours)
Price: 127 Eur/person



4. Night safari by reindeer

After arriving by car to the Reindeer Park. We take a reindeer sledge ride through the quiet winter forest to a campfire site where we roast sausages and have a cup of traditional Finnish coffee. If the night sky is clear, we may see the Northern Lights (Aurora Borealis) dancing in the sky. We return to the Park on the sledges and unharness the reindeer after which we are driven back to town by car.

5. Arctic trip by snowmobiles

Are you interested in learning how to drive this arctic vehicle? Even if you are an experienced driver, this is a good way to see the snow-covered nature of Lapland. We drive on varying tracks in the winter forests and on the icy rivers and lakes. You have an excellent opportunity to take pictures of the beautiful landscape.

6. Snowmobile safari to the reindeer farm

We drive by snowmobiles to a Lappish reindeer farm, where we will become familiar with the reindeer and learn about reindeer husbandry in Finnish Lapland. We take a short ride in a reindeer sledge and receive a "Reindeer Driver's Licence". After enjoying a cup of hot coffee or berry juice in a traditional Lappish tepee, we return back to town by snowmobiles through the snow-covered forests.

7. Snowmobile safari to the Husky Man's Camp

We drive by snowmobiles along the frozen rivers and through snowy forests to the Husky Man's Camp. After arrival, we will learn about the many aspects of living with and caring for the husky dogs. Then we take a short ride on sledges pulled by these wonderful animals. We guarantee that you will be thrilled with the speed of the ride! We return back to town by snowmobiles.

8. Winter adventure by snowmobile and huskies

We hop onto our snowmobiles and drive to a husky farm. The husky dog teams are waiting there to take us on a 45-60 minute safari in the surrounding wilderness. We enjoy some hot juice by a campfire and get to know these friendly animals. After this truly unforgettable experience, we return back to town by snowmobiles.

9. Snowmobile safari to the wilderness lake

This is one of our most fascinating safaris – if you are up for the challenge! The safari brings out the best of Lapland's wild side. We drive by snowmobiles along frozen rivers and through a snowy landscape to a peaceful wilderness lake. Once we arrive, we try our luck at ice fishing. A Lappish style outdoor lunch is served by the campfire. We return to town in the afternoon by snowmobiles. The driving distance is approx. 75 - 100 km.

Departure time: 10:00 (duration 5-6 hours)
Price: 176 Eur/person
Supplement: 88 Eur/person (1 person/snowmobile)



10. Arctic Circle Magic

We will drive by snowmobiles across the icy rivers and through snow-covered forests up to the Arctic Circle. During the day we will visit Reindeer Park where we meet the reindeer herder himself and get familiar with reindeer husbandry. We also take part in Ceremony of Crossing the Arctic Circle and have a short ride with the reindeer. During your visit to Santa Claus' Village at the Arctic Circle you meet Santa Claus in his Official Office and have time to send postcards with a special Arctic Circle stamp from his Main Post Office. You can also visit the handicraft and souvenir shops of Santa's Village. Before leaving Santa Claus' Village by snowmobiles, we will enjoy lunch at a restaurant.

Activity days: Tue, Thu, Sat
Departure time: 10:00 (duration 6 hours)
Price: 178 Eur/person
Supplement: 49 Eur/person (1 person/snowmobile)



11. Night safari by snowmobile

We leave the city lights of Rovaniemi behind and drive into the wilderness by snowmobiles. We enjoy a light evening snack by a campfire and, if we are lucky, we might see the Northern Lights (Aurora Borealis) dancing in the sky. We return back to town by snowmobiles later in the evening.

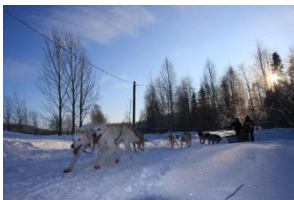

12. Aurora Borealis excursion

In the evening we make our way by car outside of Rovaniemi, away from the city lights. From there we walk to a peaceful location in search of the Aurora Borealis – the Northern Lights. We will enjoy a hot drink by a campfire and we will also have an opportunity to take a walk on snowshoes. If the sky is clear we may see the Aurora Borealis dancing in the sky! Return to your hotel by car.

Departure time: 19:00 (duration 2.5 hours)
Price: 73 Eur/person



13. Husky excursion

We will be taken by car to the husky farm. We are greeted by the friendly huskies that will take us on a husky-sledge safari through the frosty forest and over snowy meadows. You will learn how to control your own team of sledge dogs and enjoy the quiet ride once the dogs start to run. The driving time with the huskies is 1h 30 min – 1h 45 min. The safari ends at the farm with a cup of hot juice. Transfer back to town by car

Sustainability

Season

The safaris are operated daily from the 1st of December 2011 until the 15th of April 2012 for a minimum of 2 full paying adults.

Duration

Safari duration includes departure from/arrival at the Wild North office.

Bookings

Price includes

- Use of equipment for outdoor activities - thermal overalls, shoes, wool socks, gloves, helmets, fuel, meals and/or coffee breaks as mentioned in the itinerary
- transport as defined in the itinerary
- guide services in English
- value added tax (VAT)
- Children 4-14 years receive a 50% discount, unless otherwise stated. On snowmobile safaris discount is valid only when child is sitting in a sledge pulled by the snowmobile. Please note: 1 December 2011 - 10 January 2012, the child discount is 25%. Children under 4 years free of charge.
- Supplement for solo use of snowmobile is 49 € unless otherwise stated in the program.

Prices are quoted in Euro (EUR). Prices and all programme costs are subject to change without notice.

Changes and Cancellations

Changes and cancellations must be submitted to Wild North Monday through Friday by 16.00 one day prior to the safari departure. Prepaid safaris will not be refunded.

General information

Safaris and excursions are suitable for all. No previous experience is required. However husky and snowshoe excursions are somewhat more physically demanding than our other safaris and are therefore not recommended for people with restricting physical disabilities.

Technical instruction is provided before all safaris so that all participants have sufficient knowledge of how to manoeuvre the vehicles. Additional emphasis is placed on the special safety regulations regarding every aspect of the safaris.

As a responsible safari organiser, Wild North reserves the right to change the routing, schedules and duration of the excursions if necessary due to prevailing weather conditions or if deemed advisable for safety reasons and the comfort of the participants. We also reserve the right to discontinue the safari if a participant is seen as a potential danger to self or others, or is in poor health.

The snowmobile safaris are operated with 2 persons per snowmobile. Driving a snowmobile under the influence of alcohol is prohibited by Finnish law. According to Finnish law, snowmobile drivers must be at least 15 years of age and in possession of a valid driver's license. Snowmobiles are insured as required by Finnish law. This insurance covers medical care for injuries of the driver and the passenger arising from accidents. The maximum personal liability for damage caused to a snowmobile is € 800 per accident.

Please keep an identification card (passport or similar) with you on our excursions. Personal travel insurance is recommended.
